New SED & SLI ...

In October of 2000 the US government made some changes to the Shipper's Export Declaration (SED). There were over six new fields added and changes were made to the column format. The new SED is now mandatory for all exporters (as of April 1, 2001.) Because of the changes to the SED we also had to change the format of our Shipper's Letter of Instruction (SLI). In SHIPS the SLI is based on the same fields as the SED. We sent all SHIPS users the new SED and SLI on disk with installation instructions. If you did not receive them please let us know and we will forward you a copy.

Bill of Lading Module ...

We have often been asked if we offer a Bill of Lading Module. Because so many people asked us about this, it is now the latest module available in SHIPS. This is available not only to importers and exporters, but to domestic shippers as well. This module will allow for a Bill of Lading (BOL) form to be created from both a sales order and/or a DRP order. The format of the BOL is compliant with the Voluntary Inter-Industry Commerce Standard (VICS). Using this module will save time for those who use a Bill of Lading on a regular basis.



The SHIPS Import Module is designed to make the importing process simpler. This allows companies to manage the costs of importing, obtain the duty drawback they are entitled to, and have accurate and verifiable records to substantiate their claims.

The above features are in the current version of SHIPS 3.0. A more detailed list of the above changes can be found in our 3.0 press release. We will periodically send out a newsletter to inform SHIPS users of our upgrades. If you have any questions we encourage you to call.

The developers of the SHIPS package are always working on improving the software. Our plans are to globalize the SHIPS package so it can be used by overseas companies as well as those in the United States. This globalization feature, though not complete, has great potential in the international market. Currently our package is in use in Ireland and Canada.
